

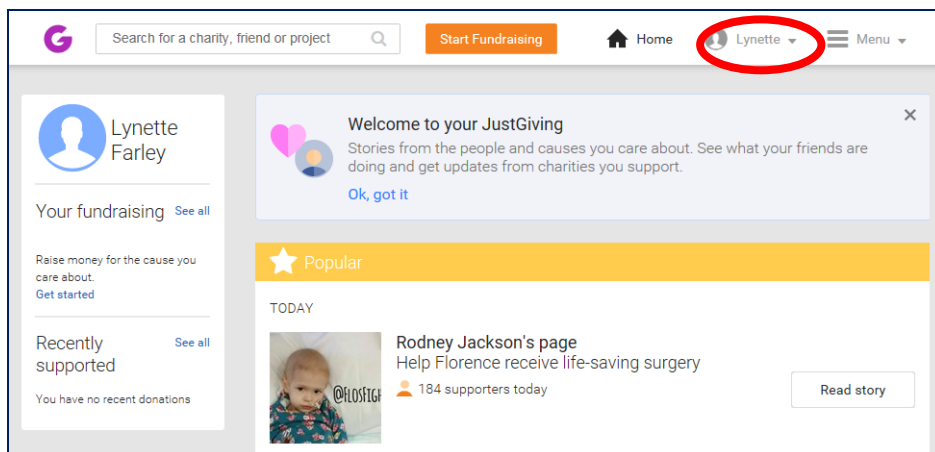

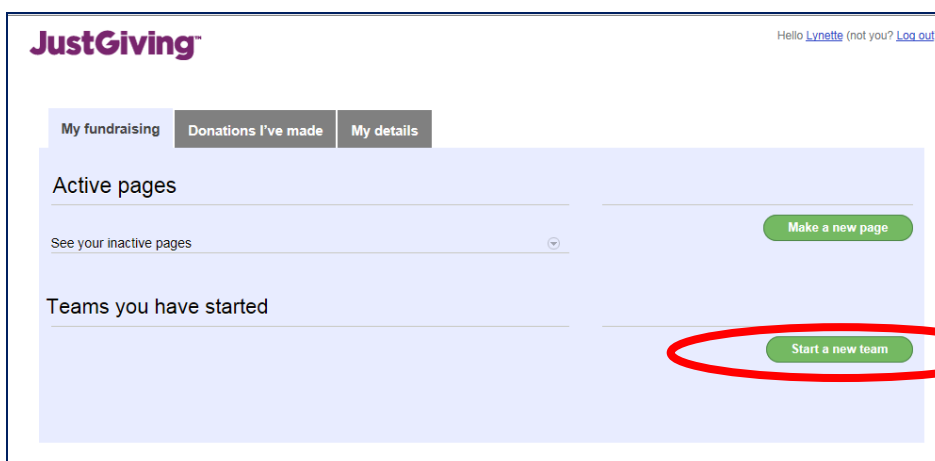

To create your own JustGiving page as part of the North Downs Walk for Cancer Research UK, please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to www.justgiving.com
2. Select **'Sign Up'** or **'Log In'** to create or access your JG account
3. Once you are logged in, **select your name** in top right corner



4. Select **'Your Fundraising'**
5. Select **'Start a New Team'**

Make a team page

You will be the **team administrator**. The administrator is responsible for managing team members. You can change these preferences at any time by logging into your account.

How do people join this team?

Open - Anyone can join this team

Closed - Anyone wanting to join must be approved

- a. **Enter your Team Name** – This can be your name (or something more imaginative if you like)!
- b. **Enter Team Link** - it should be the same as your Team Name if it is available on Just Giving
- c. Select if you'd like your team to be **open or closed** (only approved members can join or anyone can join your team)
- d. **Select Fundraising currency**
- e. **Choose your Fundraising target**
- f. Select **'Make a New Fundraising Page'**




